## Our supply chains

All of our suppliers are based in the United Kingdom and therefore we consider them as being lower risk.

All persons working for or engaged by Davidsons will be made aware of our policy and are encouraged to raise concerns about any issue or suspicion of modern slavery in any parts of our business or supply chain or of any supplier at the earliest possible stage, by reporting it in accordance with our Public Interest Disclosure Policy.

Our policies and processes are reviewed at least annually to assess their effectiveness and to ensure that we are adopting best practice.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54 (1) of the Act and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31 December 2021.
