### **ANTI-SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATEMENT**

Davidsons Developments Ltd (“Davidsons”) is committed to ensuring that we comply with our obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (“the Act”) and to ensure that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business.

Our internal Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy demonstrates our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships by implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure that slavery and trafficking are not taking place anywhere within our supply chains.

In order to ensure that all persons within our supply chain comply with Davidsons values and ethics we have updated our procedures and all potential new suppliers, contractors, subcontractors etc. will be informed of our policy and asked to confirm their commitment to our standards. All existing suppliers, contractors, subcontractors etc. will also be sent the relevant information on our policy.

All persons working for or engaged by Davidsons will be made aware of our policy and are encouraged to raise concerns about any issue or suspicion of modern slavery in any parts of our business or supply chain or of any supplier at the earliest possible stage, by reporting it in accordance with our Public Interest Disclosure Policy.

We will carry out regular reviews and will look to ensure that we are adopting best practice.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54 (1) of the Act and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31 December 2019.
